42nd CIRCUIT JUDICIAL COURT RULE



Appropriate attire shall be worn while in Court. Inappropriate attire includes tank tops, sleeveless shirts, crop shirts, shorts, sweatpants, lounge pants, pajamas, t-shirts depicting inappropriate photos or language.

Appropriate shoes shall be worn while in Court. Inappropriate shoes include flip flops, slippers and house shoes.

Hats or caps must be removed while in the Courtroom.

Violation of this prohibition will result in your case being placed on recall for one hour to give you time to change into appropriate clothing/shoes and return to court. Subsequent violations of this prohibition may be viewed by the Court as contempt, resulting in jail.

MOBILE DEVICES

NO MOBILE DEVICES ARE PERMITTED IN THE COURTROOM.

Violation of this prohibition will result in the mobile device being seized by the Bailiff.
